SAF Program Fee Details

These SAF program fees are based on our host university's 2006-2007 fee schedules. The 2007-2008 program fees will be made available once our host universities announce their fee increases, typically in March or April. Any increase in university fees will be passed along to the student. In recent years, annual tuition and fee increases in Australia have been in the range of 3% to 5%.

Tuition

The SAF program fees are based on the arts and social science tuition charged by the host university. However, some universities charge a higher tuition for disciplines such as science, engineering, and or other specialty areas involving laboratory, studio, or field work or heavily in demand disciplines such as business. The SAF passes the difference between the arts and social science tuition and the charges for special subjects along to the student as a tuition differential. Tuition differential fees will be determined once university enrollment is finalized.

Inclusions

The SAF program fees include: tuition and mandatory student fees, housing while classes are in session (typically in shared accommodation), and SAF student support services, less any scholarships, grants or fee remissions received from host universities, SAF or other organizations.

English Language Programs

To support students in their efforts to become proficient in English, many SAF programs include a "pre-semester" or "pre-sessional" ESL program (ESL + Semester). These programs allow students to undertake an English language program that prepares them for academic enrollment in February (Semester 1) or July (Semester 2).

On the SAF program fee chart, we have provided a program fee for the single ESL option we believe will best meet the needs of the largest number of prospective students. Student's who require an alternative ESL start date, should refer to the SAF ESL Program Start Dates Calendar to determine a start-date that better meets their individual circumstances. The SAF will then provide a program fee based upon their alternative ESL start date.

Conditional Admission

Many of the SAF host universities and colleges will provide conditional letters of admission. This allows SAF students with insufficient TOEFL scores to earn an acceptance to a SAF host university without demonstrating English proficiency. Students will be required to attend an ESL program at their host university or an alternate SAF host university until the required English proficiency is met. Interested students should contact SAF with help in appropriately combining an ESL program with the host university of their choice.

Housing

The cost of housing is included in the SAF program fee and is based on the average cost of local, student, self-catering accommodations, usually a shared room in a dormitory or university apartment without any extra features. When a student is assigned a single room or to a full-service dormitory which includes a mandatory meal plan, there will be a supplementary charge which may include some of the following expenses: meal plan cost, housing application fee, damage deposit, telephone or computer linkage fees, etc. The SAF program fee includes the cost of housing when classes are in session and during mandatory orientation programs. At the discretion of the host university, students may be able to remain in university housing over vacation periods at an additional charge.

Housing Deposit

Most SAF host universities will require students to pay a housing security deposit. Payment of this fee is separate from the SAF program fee and the balance will be refunded directly to the student by the host university after the completion of the program, less any damages, fines, or outstanding debts in the student's name.

Arrival Transportation

The SAF program fee includes the cost of transportation from the SAF designated arrival airport closest to the host university at the start of the program. Typically students will be pre-booked on an airport shuttle service.

Student Visa Requirements

SAF participants will need to secure a student visa to study abroad in Australia. As part of the visa application process, SAF participants are required to demonstrate that they have sufficient financial resources to cover the total estimated expenses of their study abroad experience, including personal and travel expenses not included in the SAF program fee. The SAF program fee summary provides both the SAF program fee and the estimated total cost of attendance. Official documentation of students' financial resources (i.e., bank statements) for the total estimated expenses is required at the time of application to the SAF.

Personal Cost Estimates (in Australia Dollars)

Although students' cost of living will vary depending upon the host city and students' personal spending habits, the SAF has established the following financial estimates that are based upon students living a comfortable but modest student lifestyle:

Cost of Living Estimates:

- Meals: \$3,300 AUD per year; \$1,650 AUD per semester. Most university accommodation is self-catering.
- Books and Supplies: \$800 AUD per year; \$400 AUD per semester
- Health Insurance – Australian National Health Insurance included in SAF Program Fee
- Supplemental Health/Travel Insurance: \$300 AUD per year; \$150 AUD per semester
- Personal Expenses: \$3,500 AUD per year; \$1,750 AUD per semester (includes local transportation)
- International Travel: \$1,000 AUD
